

KCSC Meeting – Public Forum – 4 February 2016

During the course of the Kelley's Corner Improvement Initiative, the Kelley's Corner Steering Committee (KCSC) held several public forums and public meetings where various plans or proposals were displayed and members of the public, area businesses, and other interest groups asked questions, made suggestions, and provided advice.

One such meeting took place on February 4, 2016. An agenda was posted for this public meeting.

The meeting took place in Room 204 of the Acton Town Hall. It started at 7:00 pm.

This meeting attracted a lot of attention. It was the official release of the plan for the Kelley's Corner Improvement Initiative.

More than 120 people attended this public forum. There were more people than chairs. The people had the opportunity to address many of the aspects of this project including roadways, crosswalks, zoning, and safety.

People left over the course of the evening. About 40 people were still in the room when the meeting ended at approximately 8:50 pm.

Some feedback from these meetings was incorporated into later iterations of the plans for Kelley's Corner.
