The contract with Cadmus has been extended to June 30, 2019 for any additional edits. A final report will be sent to the Board to review at their next meeting in June.

Ms. Cousins moved that the Green Advisor Board encourages the Town to use this opportunity of re-negotiating the Acton Power Choice (APC) Program to further increase the amount of renewable energy in the standard level of the APC Program to Town customers; Ms. Smith 2nd; unanimous.


