Re-roof using "Architectural" asphalt shingles. Color to be selected by owner/applicant.

*Excluded under Chapter P, Sect. 9.3: "...repair or replacement of any exterior architectural feature... which does not involve a change in design, material, or the outward appearance thereof,"...

Conditions, requirements, recommendations:

- Replacement shingles shall be high-definition style. Ultra-high definition style shingles are not permitted.
- Drip edge color must match wood trim color.
- Ridge vent (if used) must run from gable end to gable end.
- Chimney flashing (if used) must be lead or lead-coated copper. Mill finish aluminum is not permitted.
- Any vent pipe flashing visible from School Street must be black neoprene, copper or lead-coated copper. Mill finish aluminum is not permitted.
- Vent pipes should be metal; if PVC then PVC should be painted a dark color.
- K-style gutter to be repaired or replaced (with exact match) as needed.

- **Required: if the roof pitch is at least 3:12 pitch the roof should be shingled.**

The applicant may proceed with the proposed work provided all other approvals have been obtained, including a Building Permit or Sign License where required. This Certificate is valid for work commenced within one year of the date of issuance. An extension or renewal of the Certificate may be granted at the discretion of the commission. If a property changes ownership during the time the Certificate is in force, a new owner who wishes to continue the authorized work must apply to have a new Certificate issued in his or her own name.

Hi Barbara,

I am sorry for the delay in this application and related documentation.

The West Action Baptist Church project is reroofing the bathroom addition on the west side of the building. The roof is approximately 14'X24'. The existing shingled roof is spongy and brittle and the gutter is falling off.

The issue is the roof has only a 4 pitch and we are advised to use rubber roofing in this case. Our question is what would the Commission recommend in this instance?

The existing white gutter system will also be replaced.
All old roofing material will be removed and will be recycled.
