Green Communities and Grant Application submission

Submission for Green Communities was made May 14. Kate had a conversation with Kelly Brown our regional representative of Green Communities Program on May 19 and they are in consideration of applications.

Need to Present application to the BOS and School Committee. Need to get the benchmark out into people's hands.

Expect to hear as to whether we are accepted into the Green Community the middle of next week. If accepted, we will need to submit the grant application by the end of May.

40 towns passed stretch code; not all will be/can apply to be a Mass "green community."

Grant Applications Prospects:

- Heating System at RJ Gray. Around \$800K
 - o Engineering evaluations are being performed.
 - o Savings would be substantial to current broken system.
- Library Energy Efficiency Measure Upgrades.
 - o Dry cooler
- Town Hall Windows.
 - o 50% of funding from CPA.
- Town Hall.
 - o Radiant heating for ground floor.
- End User Education Program.

DOER uses the following criteria in their consideration of grant applications:

1. Viability. Engineering studies.

2. Energy use reduction.

Natural Gas – more Dense. Reductions in NG are more valuable to DOER whereas electricity is more expensive and likely more valuable to town
