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# GENERAL INFORMATION & PROGRAM GUIDELINES

**REGISTRATION:** Registration begins for classes once published online at: [actonrec.com](http://actonrec.com) and/or in print. You can register online at [www.actonrec.com](http://www.actonrec.com) or in person at the Recreation Department located at 50 Audubon Drive in South Acton, use our 24/7 drop-box located at the front double door entry at 50 Audubon Drive or mail to our mailing address: 472 Main Street, Acton, MA 01720, with your signed registration form and payment. There are no additional fees assessed for non-residents. You are welcome to register at any time for a program, provided it is not past a posted registration deadline. All program registrations are on a first-come, first-serve basis. Registrations are not submitted through instructors; registration must be made online, by mail or in person, prior to attending a class.

**PAYMENT:** We accept cash, money orders, checks, MasterCard or VISA. A 3% credit card fee is applied to all credit card charges. Checks and money orders are made payable to: "Town of Acton." Out-of-state checks will not be accepted. One check can pay for multiple programs. Class fee proration is at the discretion of the Recreation Director.

**PROXY REGISTRATIONS, PROGRAM CONFIRMATION & DISCLAIMER:** A person may submit another's registration form, provided the form is properly completed and signed. The Recreation Department reserves the right to correct mistakes or adjust program fees made in this brochure or online at the time of release by print or internet and cancel any program due to low enrollment or inclement weather. Confirmations are not mailed out. All registrations are considered accepted unless you are contacted – no news is good news!

**FINANCIAL AID:** Financial Aid for summer programs is available for qualifying Acton and Boxborough residents through the Doli Atamian Campership Program. To apply, please visit: [www.doliatamiancampership.com](http://www.doliatamiancampership.com).

**PHOTO POLICY:** Acton Recreation Department events are often photographed for promotional purposes. If you do not wish to be included in Recreation photos, please indicate this to the photographer.

**HOURS:** Town offices are closed on Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving and the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Years Day, Martin Luther King Day, Presidents Day, Patriots Day, Memorial Day, and Independence Day. Acton Recreation Department staffed programs/classes do not run on these dates. Town Hall business hours are Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, 8-5 PM, Tuesday, 8-7:30 PM and Friday 8 AM-12 PM. Registration forms (in envelope addressed to "Recreation Dept.") may be dropped in the message drop 24/7 located outside the Town Hall lower parking lot entrance. Independent contracted instructors may run programs on these holidays.

**REFUNDS & WITHDRAWALS:** You may withdraw from a class up to 7 (seven) business days prior to the start date—a non-refundable administrative fee of \$25 will be applied to all registrations. After that time, no refunds will be issued. All requests must be submitted in writing to the Recreation Department requesting withdrawal and refund request. Refund/Withdrawal requests are not accepted through instructors or by phone. Refunds will not be made for classes missed due to inclement weather. Exception to policy: a written letter from a licensed physician excusing participant from a program prior to 1st class. Show tickets are non-refundable but can be transferred. Tickets must be picked up in person at the Recreation Department office during regular office hours. Lost tickets are not the responsibility of the Recreation Department. **Bus Trip Refund Policy** will be outlined in the trip description. Participants are able to purchase trip cancellation insurance from the bus company if available at an additional cost directly with the bus company. **NARA Camp and Beach Refund/Withdrawal Policy** is outlined on its registration form. **Please inquire prior to any registration if you have any refund questions.**

**CLASS CANCELLATION POLICY:** Classes are cancelled if Acton-Boxborough Schools are closed due to weather. Notification via e-mail for Recreation Dept. staffed programs will be made if a class is cancelled due to weather or field conditions. Programs run by our independent contracted instructors are responsible to notify participants of class cancellations/changes. **Efforts will be made to makeup weather cancelled classes, but are not guaranteed. Any class cancellations due to an illness of an instructor will be made up or refunded. Refunds will not be offered due to a participant's inability to participate in make-up sessions. If a program is cancelled by the Acton Recreation Department due to an inability to run the program, a full refund will be issued. If a program is cancelled by instructor or Recreation Dept. due to a pandemic, a full refund will be issued.**

**BUS TRIPS:** Bus trips will run if the minimum number of registrations is received. Our trips are merged with other local towns to help meet the minimum required. If a trip is cancelled due to the lack of minimum participants, a full refund will be issued. Please note that pickup/drop-off locations are subject to change if an adequate number of registrations is not received for a pickup location in Acton. Refunds will not be issued for a non-Acton pick-up/drop-off location. In the event of illness, a trip can be transferred but not refunded once a commitment has been made. If you have any refund questions, please inquire prior to signing up. Individual bus trip refund policies will be outlined in the trip description. **BUS TRIP SPECIAL NEEDS INFORMATION:** If you consider yourself to be a person with special needs, we respectfully request that you travel with a companion who can assist you. This way we can be sure that your safety and comfort is not compromised. Please call us to discuss the details and demands of the activity before signing up for bus trips.

## TOWN OF ACTON FIELDS AND FACILITIES USES AND LOCATIONS

**ACTON RECREATION DEPARTMENT (50 Audubon Drive):** This is the main office for Acton Recreation. The facility has two large rentable multi-purpose rooms, stage and a commercial kitchen.

**CAMP ACTON (362 Pope Road):** Camp Acton has a variety of wooded campsites available for rental through the Acton Recreation Department. Application: [www.actontrails.org/CampActonForm.pdf](http://www.actontrails.org/CampActonForm.pdf)

**CONCORD ROAD FIELD (104 Concord Road):** This field is located on Concord Road between Ice House Pond and the Woodlawn Cemetery entrance. It is a multi-use soccer field.

**ELM STREET FIELDS (19 Elm Street):** The playing fields are located on Elm Street next to the Douglas School in W. Acton. The Elm Street recreation area consists of a playground, two tennis courts, basketball court, softball diamond with night lighting, and a small soccer field.

**GARDNER FIELD (530 Mass Ave.):** This field consists of a playground, basketball hoop and field area.

**GOWARD PLAYGROUND (486 Main Street):** The playground is located behind the Acton Memorial Library in Acton Center.

**GREAT HILL/LITTLE GREAT HILL (54 School Street):** The Great Hill fields are located on School Street behind the S. Acton Fire Station. Great Hill field contains a soccer field located adjacent to the Great Hill Conservation Area. Little Great Hill field contains a small soccer field and is located left of the Great Hill Field through a marked wooded path.

**HART FIELD/MACPHERSON FIELD (80 Taylor Road):** Located at the Conant Elementary School and each houses a Little League Baseball Diamond.

**HERBERT FARM COMMUNITY GARDEN (88 Prospect Street):** Located across the street from Ace Hardware. This is an organic farm with approximately 32 garden plots. Registration for plots is through the Cemetery Department.

**ICE HOUSE POND (120 Concord Road):** Ice House Pond is located off Concord Road next to the Morrison Farm. This pond has fishing and a parking area.

**JOSEPH LALLI MIRACLE FIELD (75 Quarry Road):** This all-accessible facility consists of a fenced baseball field with a rubberized surface.

**JONES FIELD (54 Martin Street):** This facility consists of an open field and playground.

**MORRISON FARM COMMUNITY GARDENS (116 Concord Road):** Located between Woodlawn Cemetery and Ice House Pond. This is an organic farm with approximately 50 plots. Registration for plots is through the Cemetery Department.

**NARA PARK (25 Ledge Rock Way):** NARA is home to the Recreation Department's Summer Camp, Concerts and Special Events. NARA consists of a bathhouse with a snack bar, 9-acre swimming pond, 500' beach, large amphitheater, 2 volleyball courts, softball field, 7-acres of recreational fields, 1-mile walking path, Miracle Field and access to the Bruce Freeman Rail Trail. There is also a large three-winged picnic pavilion and tented picnic area available to rent. The park is open year-round during daylight hours.

**NORTH ACTON COMMUNITY GARDENS (845 Main Street):** There are approximately 45 garden plots. Registration for plots is through the Cemetery Department.

**ROBBINS MILL RECREATION AREA (61 Canterbury Hill Road):** Located in the Robbins Mill subdivision. Contains a 120' x 180' junior soccer field, basketball court, playground and picnic shelter.

**SCHOOL STREET FIELDS (343-347 School Street):** The fields are located at the end of School Street off Rt. 2 east. This field consists of two Cricket and multi-use recreational fields.

**TJ O'GRADY MEMORIAL SKATE PARK (66 Hayward Rd.):** The park is located near the ABRHS lower fields on Hayward Road. The park is open during daylight hours for skateboarding and roller blading.

**VETERANS FIELD (655 Main Street):** Veterans Field is located at the intersection of 2A/Rt. 27. The field consists of two Little League diamonds and a playground.

## Camp Acton

Reservations are required for use of a campsite at Camp Acton located off Pope Road. All users must complete a permit application that can be found by visiting [actonma.gov/recreation](http://actonma.gov/recreation) and going to Field and Facilities.

Camp Acton, which was formerly owned by the Boston Minuteman Boy Scout Council, is the only Acton conservation land able to accommodate individual or group picnicking or overnight camping. Seven relatively level campsites that are stone-free and dry remain from the Boy Scout ownership. Each has space for several tents and is maintained free of poison ivy, brambles, and other undergrowth. Within easy access of the parking area, each site is equipped with a picnic table, a stone campfire ring, and a firewood box and is located in a woody setting that allows some privacy. Short paths off an old woods road lead to each site. Permits are required for camping and may be obtained from the Recreation Department. A portable toilet is located in the parking lot, but no water is provided. Close to the parking area is a large fieldstone fireplace, apparently the remains of an earlier structure. However, it is not suitable for any type of fire in its current condition.




